Resurfacing work will be taking place on the road outside the main entrance to the Hospice, on Monday 13th and Tuesday 14th February, and access to the Hospice will be disrupted.

Access

Access to the main entrance of the Hospice building will be disrupted during this time, although specific timings for this have not been confirmed.

Signs will be put up to direct drivers and pedestrians, and road workers will also be on hand to give directions and information.

Parking

You will not be able to park on Menin Way while it is being resurfaced, and if you do, your car may be towed away.

You may also not be able to access the main Hospice car park, and so may have to park on other roads nearby.

PLEASE NOTE: If you park in the Hospice car park during the day, **YOU MAY NOT BE ABLE TO LEAVE UNTIL AFTER 5pm.**

We understand that this may cause inconvenience – please do let us know if you have any specific problems or queries.

Noise

There will be some noise but the road workers will try to keep it to a minimum.

Delays

Resurfacing work can sometimes be delayed by bad weather. If this happens, we will keep you updated via the TV screens in reception and the coffee shop.
